What it's all about...

Well, since you have received this newsletter, that means you are one of the 218 or so who have registered for German Nash Hash 2016, the 28th meeting of the Teutonic HHH Kennels.

The theme this year is “Neanderthal”,

i.e., those pre-historic *Homo Sapiens* who dragged their knuckles around this area about 50,000 years ago. And, guess what? We'll be running around, grunting and snorting like our forefathers did, in their very own hunting grounds – so to speak.

We've got less than one week to go before the event kicks off, so in case you have did not read the previous newsletter about logistics, i.e., how to get to the general Düsseldorf area and when, then you should read RTFM.

The main event kicks off on Friday, 17 June at 15:00 hours (that's 3:00 p.m. for the Anglo-Saxons, et al.) and continues on until Sunday, 19 June at the same time. For those hard-core hashers who just cannot get enough hills, valleys, shiggy and beer, Snake Charmer and Rob The Pom are organizing a **Pre-Lube on Thursday, 16 June**, in the Bonn-Königswinter area next to the Siebengebirge Mountains, which are famous for their *fairytale*

and other Hashing exploits. So dress up as *Hansel & Gretel* or even *Yogi the Bear*. And, for those real die-hard hashers, **Colonel Clit and Slot Machine will be setting a Full Moon Hash on Monday, 20 June**, in Cologne – in the evening. **Theme: Full Moon or Neon.**

And on **Friday evening, 17 June**, we will have a **Red Dress Run** through the Altstadt of Düsseldorf, so **don't forget to bring your RED DRESS costumes.**

This costs a paltry 5€ extra, but you will get to taste hand-crafted *Altbier* from three of the 200+ pubs in the Old City. For those who do not participate in the **Red Dress Run**; you are “on your own” in town.

GNH2016 Main Venue

Düsseldorf Youth Hostel (YH), located at **Düsseldorfer Strasse 1** in the district of **Oberkassel on the west side of the Rhine River**. It is easily reachable in 30 minutes or so from Düsseldorf Airport by train, subway/metro/tube and bus or tram with an “A” ticket for 2.60€.

For those participating in the Pre-Lube, you may consider flying into Cologne Bonn Adenauer Airport and staying at a hotel or YH in that area on Thursday evening. Trains run several times an hour between Düsseldorf and Cologne / Bonn, but it is up to you to decide.

The same goes for the Post-Lube in Cologne. You may want to pack your stuff on Sunday afternoon and make your way to Cologne or just stay in Düsseldorf and take one of the frequent trains on Monday to the Full Moon Run. Of course, you would then have to stay sober enough to be back in Düsseldorf after the run. ☺

Additional Nights in Youth Hostel

Your registration fee covers two nights' accommodation, namely Friday and Saturday night, with check-out on Sunday before 10:30. If you wish to arrive earlier or stay later, you can reserve a room before/after the GNH2016 event; either in Düsseldorf, Bonn or Cologne, then use this link: <http://www.jugendherberge.de/en/> The rates are pretty much standard, less than 35€ per night in a 4-bed room, incl. breakfast.

Drivers Note

If arriving by car, you can park on a side street near the YH; Düsseldorfer Strasse has a 1 hour limit until 8 p.m. on Friday, but Sat-Sun are unlimited. The adjacent underground garage will take 12.50€ per 24 hours from your beer budget.

Schedule of Events (subject to changes, updates and MisManagement Cockups)

Thursday, 16.06., Pre-Lube Run (5€ fee) in Bonn-Königswinter, organized by Snake Charmer and Rob The Pom. This is in the Siebengebirge area, so the theme is **Fairy Tale Characters**. Info about where/when to meet is posted on the www.craph3.com website on the Pre- and Post-Lube page.

Friday, 17.06., German Nash Hash 2016 on-site registration starts at 15:00 at the Düsseldorf Youth Hostel (Jugendherberge), located at Düsseldorfer Strasse 1 in (DUH!) 40545 Düsseldorf. Check our CRAPH3 website for details. There you will get your Goody Bag and room assignment. If you will participate in the **Red Dress Run** in the evening, we will collect **5 Euros** from you and give you BEER TICKETS that you MUST take with you on the **Red Dress Run**.

Dinner will be from 18:00 until 20:00, then at about 20:00 we will gather outside (weather permitting) to greet everyone and then take off for the **Red Dress Run**. After the **Red Dress Run**, you are free to stay in the Old City and visit the 200+ pubs or return to the YH.

So take some extra money with you if you want to party on.

Saturday, 18.06. Breakfast starts at 7:30 and ends at 10:00. The bus for the **Ball Breaker Run** (about 25 km, A-B, returning to the Main Venue for the Circle) will depart from the YH at 10:00. Busses for the **Main Runs** will depart from the YH at 11:00 for the

10km and 15km r*ns and at 11:30 for the 5km walkers trail and go to the same starting location, which is located in the **Neanderthal Valley**. The 3 runs are all A-A, i.e., start/end at the same place, where the circle will be held. The 10km/15km will start at 12:00 and the 5km will start at 12:30. Hashers will return back by bus to the Main Venue at about 17:00. Dinner starts at about 17:30 and continues until 20:30. After 19:30 some time is reserved for hash skits, etc. The party (**optional, but highly encouraged Neanderthal "caveman" theme**) starts at 20:30 with a live band, KUKI&DENT, who will play until 24:00 – well, maybe a bit later. Keep in mind it is less than a 2 km walk from the Youth Hostel to the **Altstadt** area, so those with extra endurance may want to perhaps ... go for a walk?

Sunday, 19.06., breakfast is served 7:30 until 10:00. The Hangover Run starts at 10:30, so you should check-out sometime between breakfast and the starting time. We will arrange for a place where you can store your stuff until the event is over at 15:00.

The Hangover Run will begin at the back side of the Youth Hostel and follow a course of about 6 km. There will be a **traditional Drink Stop sponsored by Berlin HHH**. The final circle will take place at the Youth Hostel, where we will vote for the sponsor of German Nash Hash 2017 before closing out the event.

Monday, 20.06., there just happens to be a **Full Moon**, so **Colonel Clit and Slot Machine** are organizing a special **Post-Lube Full Moon Run** (8€ fee for r*n, BBQ and beer) in Cologne. If you want to participate, you can reserve another night (at your own expense) either at the YH in Düsseldorf or carry your bags to Cologne to spend Sunday night there.

The **Full Moon Run** begins at 19:00 and starts from the Bootshaus 'Alte Liebe' on the Rhine in Köln-Rodenkirchen. The course will be about 8 km of woods, city parks and one last look at Father Rhine. There is campground (www.camping-koeln.de) a few meters from the circle where you can pitch your tent for a modest price. Or you may stay at the nearly YH or a hotel in Cologne. Details are on the Post-Lube page of the www.craph3.com website.

How to get from the DUS Airport to the Youth Hostel?

Suggestion: The S11 S-Bahn metro train runs directly to/from the airport and links to Düsseldorf Hauptbahnhof Main Train Station in the city center. Journey time is 12 min and the fare: €2.60, which is an **"A" transfer ticket** that you can use to take the metro/subway/tube U70, U74, U75, U76 or U77 to Luegplatz, just a 10 minute, 700 meter walk to the YH. If you don't want to walk, you can take the S11 for two stations after the Main Train Station and get off at Düsseldorf-Bilk, then take Bus 835 (direction Comeniusplatz); which stops right in front of the YH.

Alternate Airport: Cologne-Bonn Adenauer Airport (CGN).

If you participate in the Pre-Lube or Post-Lube, it may be better to fly into and/or out of the airport that is closer to Cologne and Bonn. This link shows trains going from/to this airport: https://www.bahn.de/p_en/view/index.shtml

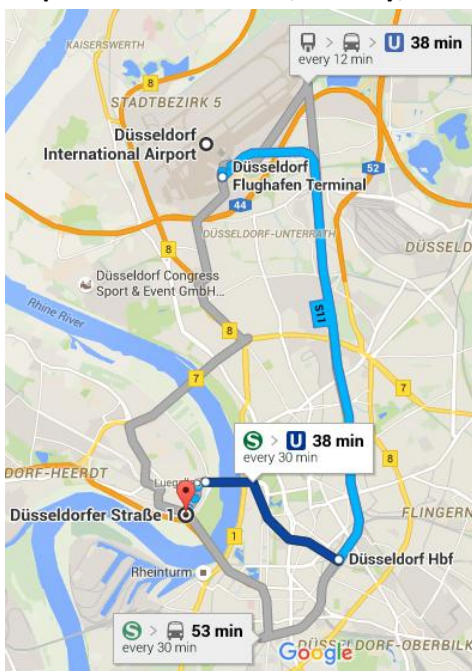

Please keep in mind!

In Germany, all beverage containers, be they "cans" or "plastic bottles", require a deposit. The deposit we have paid on the plastic (water) bottles is **25 Euro Cents (!)** each, so we kindly request that you not simply throw them away. Please put them in the plastic rubbish bags that we will provide, so that we can return them!

Thanks for your cooperation.
We are sharing the Youth Hostel with non-hashers, so you must show your wrist band and your hash mug to get a beer from the tap. If you see non-hashers trying to get some of our beers, please tell them in a friendly way that this is a private affair.

Note: The small print (Legal Waiver), which you will be asked to agree to when signing in at the official registration desk:
"I understand that 'Hashing' is an activity which involves running, walking, climbing, and crawling on all types of terrain and under all types of conditions, including but not limited to, darkness, heat, cold, rain, mud, and snow. I also understand that Hashing involves the consumption of alcohol before, during and after each run. I acknowledge that Hashing is an inherently HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY and involves a significant risk of great bodily and physical injury and/or death. I also acknowledge that other persons or persons participating in the hash may endanger me by their conduct. I expressly assume all risks associated with participating in the German Nash Hash without reservation or limitation. I agree to hold harmless and not hold legally responsible any and all persons, and not sue, or make any claim whatsoever, for any reason, including but not limited to the negligence of any party, the C.R.A.P. hash, any of its members or officers, any organizer of the weekend, or any other person or persons, for any injury, including death, loss or damage to person or property, or any other consequence arising from my participation in the German Nash Hash. I furthermore intend this waiver and agreement to specifically bind my heirs or assigns or any other person seeking to enforce or exercise any rights in conjunction with my participation in the event. I understand that my participation in the German Nash Hash is contingent upon my execution of this waiver and I hereby freely choose to participate with an understanding of all risks to my person or property."
