A further reason for the touristic attractiveness of the Siebengebirge may lie in the literary handling of this theme. The famous English poet Lord Byron mentioned the Rhine and especially the Seven Mountains in his epic poem *Childe Harold's Pilgrimage*, a timeless memorial, which led to the British Siebengebirge boom after 1830:

The castled crag of Drachenfels
Frowns o'er the wide and winding Rhine
Whose breast of waters broadly swells
Between the banks which bear the vine
And hills all rich with blossomed trees
And fields which promise corn and wine
